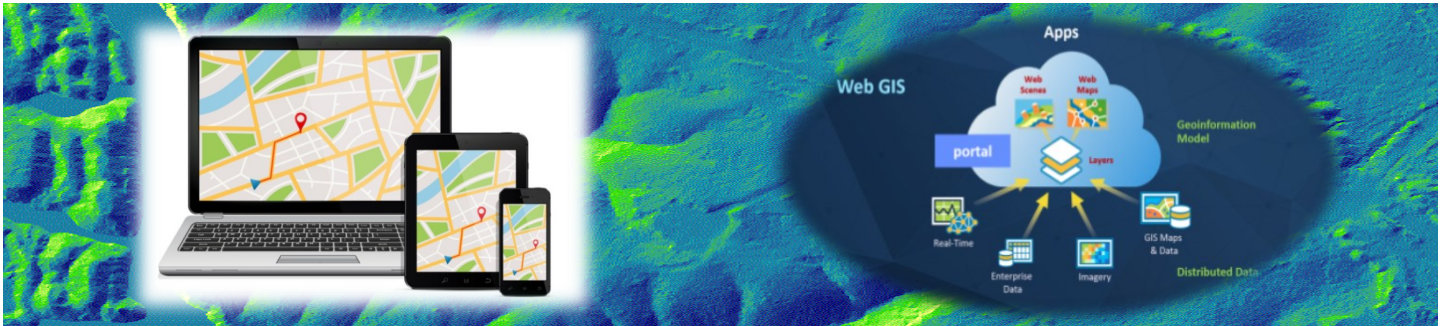

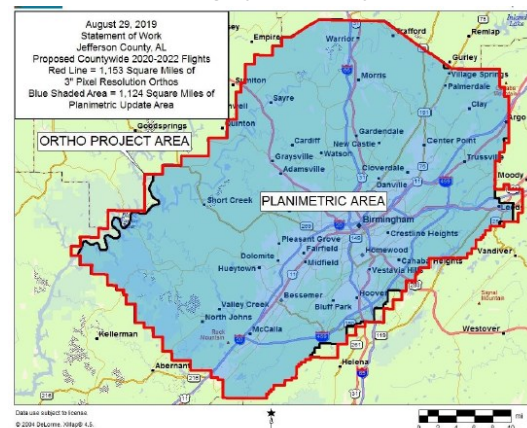
What's New in County GIS?

- Accela Permitting systems begins its 2nd phase of implementation which will include GIS updates.

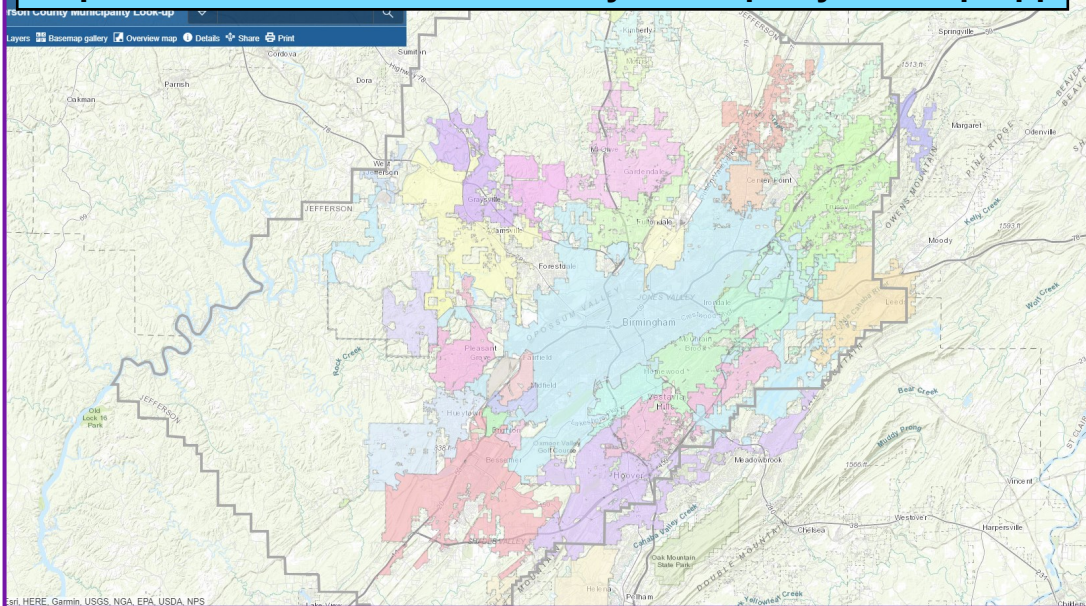

The Municipality Look-up web app is one of the resources provided in the suite of publicly available apps on our GIS web apps page. It is useful for looking up information about which municipality a property is in. You can search for property by owner name, address, or parcel ID. It will display the parcel boundary, owner and property address information and the municipality the property is in.
